



## Risk Assessment

The policy of Jobshop UK is to protect our people by reducing or minimising any risk to which our temporary staff may be exposed so as to provide a safe working environment.

### Method :-

- By visiting if necessary.
- Acquire good knowledge of both the area and conditions in which temporary staff might be placed.
- Ensure that potential employers have a coherent Risk Assessment policy in place and, if required, show typical assessment records for specific work areas and tasks.
- Verify that proper control exists in the workplace to prevent accidents or risks to health. The control mechanisms should extend to meet the needs of :- young workers, expectant mothers, visitors and contractors etc.
- The following personal protective equipment is commonly used/required in a workshop environment.
- Eye protection, ear defenders, respiratory masks, safety boots/shoes, helmets, gloves, aprons, overalls and radiation monitors.
- Temporary staff are advised of any specific requirements to wear safety clothing prior to committing to an assignment.
- General Staff are always advised on the environment and general layout of their intended workplace.

Jobshop will refuse to place persons in a risk situation, which it believes is not properly managed.
